Exploratory Studies Major (EXPL) – Typical First-Year Schedule

Fall:

SCSM 101, Springfield College Seminar (3 cr – fills FYS GenEd)
ENGL 113, College Writing I (GenEd requirement – 3 cr)
SPCO 110, Exploration: In a Major Way (1 cr)
Plus transportable GenEds or major exploratory courses to total 14 to 16 credits

Spring:

ENGL 114, College Writing II (GenEd requirement – 3 cr)
Plus transportable GenEds or major exploratory courses to total approximately 30 credits for the year

General Education Program

While all students must fulfill the following General Education Program requirements, some majors require specific courses which also fulfill GenEds. Check the Sequencing Guides for majors you're interested in and consult with your Exploratory Studies advisor for more information about recommendations for your second year. **You must apply to a new major by the end of your second year.**

Degree Requirements

To complete your Bachelor's degree, you must:

- Complete all requirements for a declared major
- Complete the General Education Program
- Earn at least 120 credits (some majors may require more)
- Earn a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.000 or higher (some majors require a higher GPA)
- Complete the residency requirement—45 credits taken at Springfield College (including 15 of your last 30)
